**COVID-19 RESPONSE –
TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS ON FUNERAL HOMES**

I am writing to advise you of temporary restrictions as part of the Australian Government's response to minimising the spread of COVID-19 in the community.

The *Public Health (Closure of Additional Non-Essential Business or Undertaking) Emergency Direction 2020* has **temporarily restricted the following activities until at least 11:59pm on 13 April 2020:**

- Funerals must not be attended by more than 10 people, social distancing of 1 person per 4 square metres must be observed.

Funerals may be held in a place of worship provided they meet these restrictions.

A copy of the direction is attached to this letter.

There are penalties for failing to comply with these temporary prohibitions. Penalties for non-compliance range from \$8,000 (50 penalty units) to \$40,500 for body corporates.

To protect public health, we will be undertaking proactive monitoring to ensure local compliance with these restrictions.

It is important that you, like all our community, practice social distancing and good hygiene practices to assist with slowing the spread of COVID-19. I have attached information on the steps you can take to help reduce the spread of germs.

We encourage businesses to contact Access Canberra who can provide information and support including around these temporary prohibitions.
